LSCAA and Fuse Duluth Work to Keep Duluth Booming

Duluth has an estimated 20,000 or more consumers that are drawn to the area by way of the local colleges, impacting the local economy by \$100 million or more annually. However, students are not often encouraged to stay in our region; instead, many receive their degrees and decide to move to the Twin Cities in search of career opportunities.

With talk of an upcoming labor shortage, there is an incredible opportunity on college campuses to engage interested students in the local business community and help them develop a network of contacts that motivate them to stay and build their careers, homes, and families in Duluth.

College Connection is a mentorship program being offered by Fuse Duluth, a division of the Duluth Area Chamber of Commerce. The program is designed to enhance the students' relationships with the business community.

College Connection has four main goals: to increase student awareness of the economic activities in our community, to increase student knowledge of the entrepreneurial spirit in Northeastern Minnesota, to provide experienced role models for juniors and seniors from our community, and to provide informal advice and counseling for students seeking to clarify their career direction.

Rad Tech Alums Fund Kim Chapman Memorial Scholarship

Radiologic technology alumni and friends, through generous donations, funded the Kim Chapman Memorial Fund at the \$10,000 level making it a fully endowed scholarship opportunity for LSC students.

An endowed scholarship allows the Radiological Technology program to award one of their students with a \$500 scholarship each year. But Rad Tech isn't stopping there – with "National Radiologic Technology Week" coming this month, the new goal is to increase the endowment of the scholarship to the \$20,000 level, allowing for either an increased scholarship for one student or the ability to give two scholarships per year.
