1. Updates and Reports

A. eLumen

Kent Richards reported he is optimistic about the level of usage but most assessments are set up for the end of the semester so we won't know until then how much usage there will actually be.

B. Computational Skills Project

Theresa Hornstein reported Jeri Essig has been working with the work group and that a new test run has been completed. Scores were similar to the first batch. Kent Richards asked about the process for a large scale assessment and for the work group to discuss their plans for that.

C. Citizenship Outcome Task Force

Deanne Roquet distributed the draft of revised outcomes from the task force. There was discussion regarding changing the outcomes and concerns were raised regarding how to measure the outcomes and it is important the outcomes are identifiable. The committee asked that the next step for the task force be to prepare rubrics for the proposed recommendations and to bring that back to SAA for further review.

D. Constitution Day / Citizenship Project

Approximately 900-950 papers were completed – the status is as follows:

- 500 scored

- 300 being scored
- 125 need to be scored – Adrienne Dinneen volunteered

Kent Richards asked that the papers be scored within the next 1-2 weeks so a report can be prepared for the next meeting in December.

2. College Wide Outcomes – Review of New and Existing Rubrics

Kent Richards distributed draft rubrics to the group and asked that they be reviewed and there will be discussion at the next meeting. Rubrics are needed for all College Wide Outcomes.
