Students Train to Identify and Reduce Invasive Species on LSC Campus

Nearly sixty LSC students enrolled in Environmental Science, General Biology and Issues in Global Ecology courses began a two-part training about invasive species on campus last week when they learned to identify and remove buckthorn by the H Building.

Using LSC's forest as a Living Lab, the students and faculty are working with the Duluth CISMA (Collaborative Invasive Species Management Area) and the

City of Duluth's Invaders volunteers. The students tackled buckthorn in the Miller Creek ravine on Wednesday, November 13 for a full field experience.
