## Students Remove Invasive Species on Lake Superior College Campus

Nearly sixty LSC students tackled removing buckthorn in three acres of the Miller Creek Interpretative Trail forest last Wednesday and near the H Building the week before.

The students, who are enrolled in Environmental Science, General Biology and Issues in Global Ecology courses, underwent a two-part training about invasive species on campus where they learned to identify and remove buckthorn and get credit for their work. Using LSC's forest as a Living Lab, the students and faculty worked with the Duluth Cisma (Collaborative Invasive Species Management Area) and the City of Duluth's Invaders volunteers.

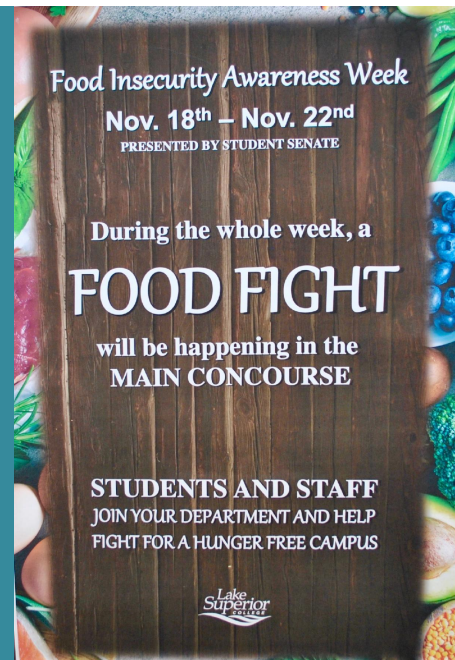
