



Manufacturing Students Put Their Designs to Test at Task Robot Competition

Robots designed and built by **Integrated Manufacturing student teams** were put to the competitive task last Monday and were featured on <u>Fox21</u> and <u>WDIO</u> news. The bots had to pick up steel marbles of a specific quantity and move them from container A to container B while traveling through an obstacle course. They were judged on staying within the course, the number of marbles deposited, and the amount of time needed to complete the task.
