Pictured below, students also enjoyed hiking Ely's Peak with the LSC Student Life team last Friday.

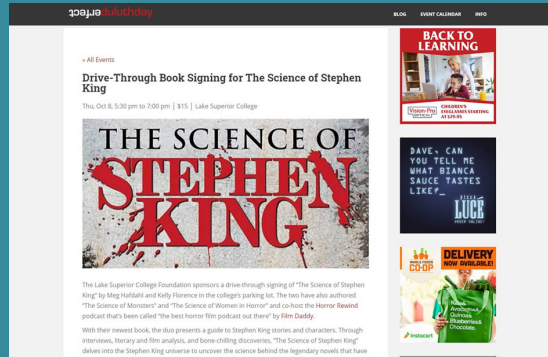

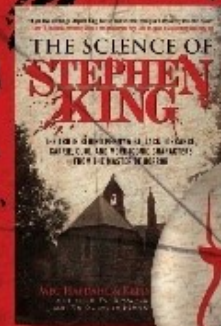
