LSC Foundation to award up to \$100,000 in Workforce Development Scholarships for eligible students!



The Lake Superior College Foundation is once again offering several <u>Workforce Development Scholarships</u> for eligible students at Lake Superior College. New and returning students who qualify can apply for one of several \$2,500 annual scholarships which will be applied starting in spring semester 2021, and can be renewed for fall semester 2021. The scholarships are for Minnesota residents, enrolled in/who will be enrolled at Lake Superior College in spring semester 2021, with at least 9 credits, and who are pursuing academic programs and careers within these specific programs:

- Advanced manufacturing (example: integrated manufacturing)
- Agriculture (example: eco-entrepreneurship)
- Health care services (examples: all healthcare related programs)
- Information technology (examples: IT/computer science)
- Early childhood education
- Transportation (examples: aviation and auto)

Current and prospective students interested in applying for these scholarships can apply now through midnight on November 15. The application process is 100% <u>online</u>.






