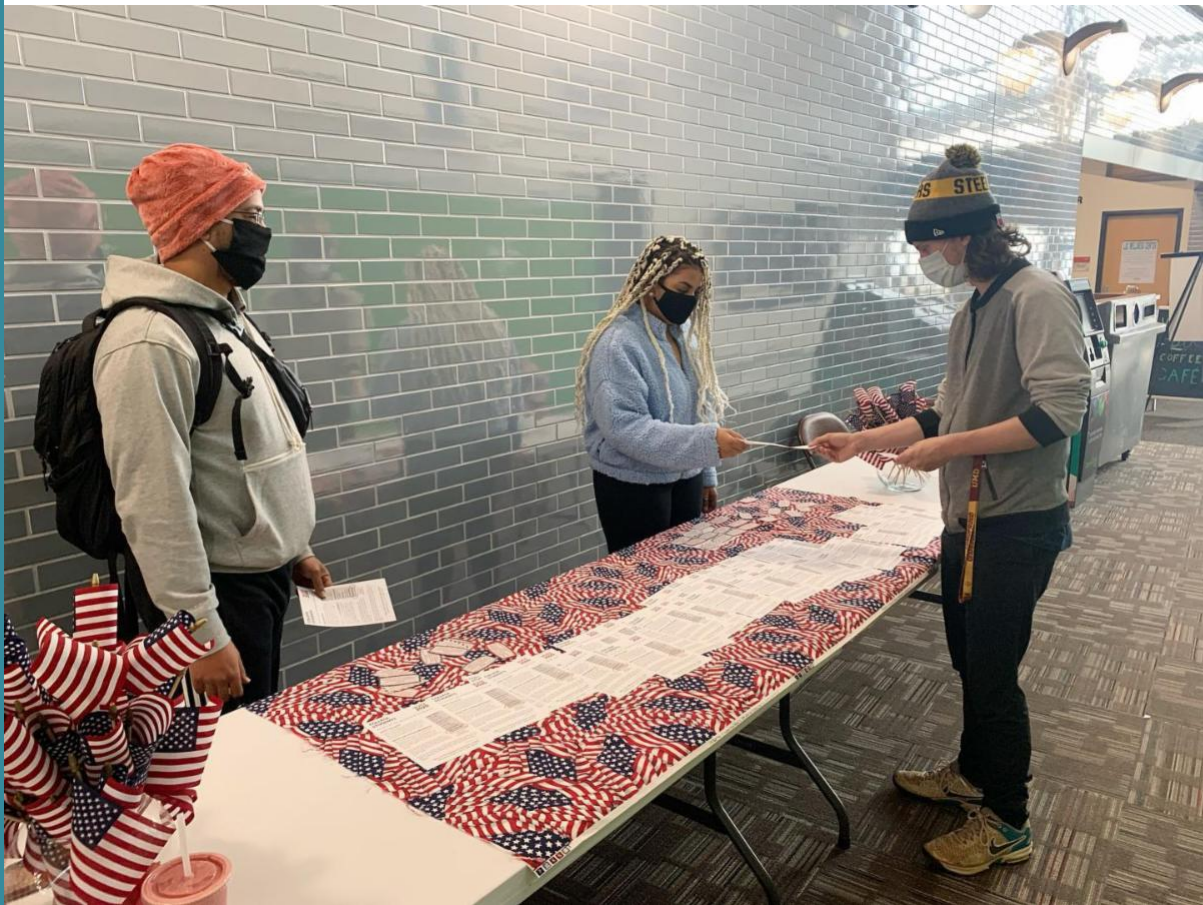
- Advanced manufacturing (example: integrated manufacturing)
