ALL IN launched <u>ALLIntoVote.org</u> as a one-stop website for campuses and students to navigate the voting process. This free site provides students with non-partisan information and tools to pledge to vote, register to vote, confirm their voter registration, determine how and where to vote, and understand what is on their ballot.

As a signatory of the <u>Presidents' Commitment</u>, the Lake Superior College campus community has full access to these resources. With the shifts in regulations around vote by mail, and as the needs for absentee ballot requests change, this site will become an essential tool for helping campuses navigate support for their geographically diverse student bodies. 


