LSC Foundation awards \$100,000 in Workforce Development Scholarships

The LSC Foundation has begun awarding \$100,000 in Workforce Development (WFD) Scholarships to 40 deserving students in approved programs. This funding is primarily provided by Minnesota State and the State of Minnesota legislature, with matching funds provided by local community and industry partners and generous donors including LSC employees, Board members, alumni and other friends of LSC/LSC Foundation. Additional WFD scholarships are also in the works and will be announced early in Spring Semester. In addition to WFD scholarships, the LSC Foundation will again offer traditional scholarships in the spring, to be applied for Fall Semester 2021. 


Upcoming Events and Campus Updates




