




Spring Semester is underway. Welcome back, IceHawks!

Lake Superior College to host Healthcare Open House on February 11

Know anyone who may be interested in learning more about the various healthcare programs at Lake Superior College? The Open House is free and open to the public; however, due to COVID-19 related restrictions, registration is required in advance and the event has been modified to ensure the safety of all guests.
