## LSC students to receive CRRSAA funding this week

As reported last week, LSC successfully distributed \$1.8 million in CRRSAA funds to students beginning on Wednesday, in \$500 and \$750 increments. This funding is made possible by the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) and was authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), signed into law on

December 27, 2020. Lake Superior College administration, in consultation with the LSC Student Senate, set up a disbursement plan to distribute more than half of relief funding dedicated to LSC directly to students.

In addition, a portion of remaining CRRSAA funds were dedicated for Emergency Grants, of up to \$500 each, through the LSC Foundation. This past week, the LSC Foundation received over 100 applications and was able to approve 82 of them, awarding a total of \$41,000. Those who applied and were not eligible were personally contacted so we can discuss eligibility requirements and other options to help get them some support. Special thanks to Karen Popp and the LSC Foundation, LaNita Robinson, the Student Success team, the marketing and web team, the Business Office and everyone involved in helping with this process. We have heard from several students, some shedding tears of joy, who have expressed their appreciation and relief. We know this has been a difficult year for many, and we are grateful for this federal support for our students and campus.



## Sign up for the COVID-19 Vaccine Connector

The State of Minnesota continues to encourage residents to sign up for the COVID-19 Vaccine Connector, a tool to help Minnesotans find when, where, and how to get their COVID-19 vaccine. All state employees, who are Minnesota residents, are encouraged to sign up on the Vaccine Connector. Signing up means you will be alerted when you are eligible for vaccination, connected to resources to schedule an appointment, and provided vaccination opportunities in your area.




