3:30 p.m. This opportunity is open to all current LSC students and employees who wish to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. They will be providing the Pfizer vaccine, and returning to campus on Thursday, May 6 to provide the required second dose. Registration is required in advance and will be done on a first come, first served basis while supplies last. You must [pre-register](#), and no walk-ins will be allowed. 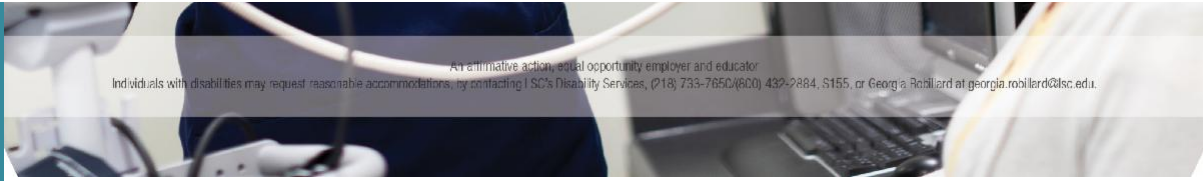
