### Lake Superior College Foundation To Award Over \$100,000 in Spring Scholarships



The <u>Lake Superior College Foundation</u> is awarding over \$100,000 in student scholarships this upcoming Spring Semester for students at Lake Superior College. The LSC Foundation scholarship application window is now open and will remain open through December 1, 2021. Current and prospective students are encouraged to apply by visiting <u>lsc.edu/foundation</u>.

The entire application process is online and requires applicants to set up an account in the AwardSpring system. Foundation scholarships are available to current (returning) and incoming students in good standing, and will be awarded to students enrolled at LSC in Spring Semester 2022.

While the majority of scholarships through the LSC Foundation are typically offered in the spring for Fall Semester, there are some program-specific scholarships being offered now (Fall Semester 2021) for Spring Semester

2022. Any eligible student who plans on attending LSC in the spring of 2022 is eligible to apply, although some scholarships have specific requirements based on conditions established by the funders. More scholarships will be offered in the spring of 2022, for Fall Semester 2022, which will include even more programs.

For this current award cycle, the following scholarships are being offered:

- Workforce Development Scholarships (multiple awards)
- Nicholas James Person RN Nursing Scholarship (new)
- St. Louis County Mineral Royalties Scholarships (multiple awards)
- Laura Hamre Nursing Careers Scholarship (new)

### LSC Celebrates First-Generation College Students






Lake Superior College and <u>TRIO Student Support Services</u> (TRIO SSS) joined colleges and universities across the country in celebrating first-generation students for First-Generation Day. First-generation college students are defined as those who come from families where their biological parents did not complete a four-year college degree. Forty-six percent of LSC students are first-generation students.

TRIO SSS offers a variety of resources and support for first-generation students and students meeting other TRIO eligibility requirements. Services include: academic advising, career exploration, scholarship application assistance, transfer advising, early registration and more. Vaccinations: Minnesota State is following the guidance from the State of Minnesota and Minnesota Department of Health on vaccinations of our students and employees. An all employee email went out on September 8, and is also available on the website.

As a reminder, please do not come to campus if you're feeling sick, symptomatic and/or had any exposure to COVID-19. This includes those mandated under Policy 1446 to complete weekly testing on campus. If you are feeling sick or feel you may have been exposed to COVID-19, please contact your healthcare provider and/or use community testing sites rather than coming to campus for testing, as we are not setup like a community testing site. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

#### \$100 Vaccination Incentive Scholarship

Lake Superior College is now offering a \$100 scholarship incentive for those who receive the COVID-19 vaccination.

#### Eligibility:

- Must be an enrolled LSC student, regardless of your home address. 100% online students are eligible.
- Must be fully vaccinated (two shots for Pfizer and Moderna, one for Johnson & Johnson) on or after August 1, 2021.
- Must provide proof of full vaccination.
- Sorry, PSEO students are not eligible.

The scholarship is disbursed through the financial aid process. To claim your \$100 scholarship, provide your student ID and proof of vaccination by:

- 1. Stopping in the financial aid office on the main campus in Student Services S105 or S107. Please note: International students will also provide a substitute W-9 form as required under federal tax law.
- 2. Emailing financial aid at: <a href="mailto:studentfa@lsc.edu">studentfa@lsc.edu</a>.
  - Provide your student ID. NOTE: International students will also provide a substitute W-9 form as required under federal tax law.
  - Take an image of your proof of vaccination.
  - Send it in to studentfa@lsc.edu.






