Erickson Library Hosts Artist Talk






The Erickson Library hosted an Artist Talk with artist Nancy XiáoRong Valentine discussing her artwork titled, The Audacity to be Asian in Rural America: we owe you no apologies. It's a series of 12 watercolor and Chinese ink scroll paintings on rice paper that visually tells the story of the artist's Chinese American immigrant ancestors' experience in rural western Minnesota. Six of the paintings are now on display at LSC's Erickson Library, with the remaining six on display at UMD. The exhibit runs through December 17.




