LSC Foundation to Award Over \$150,000 in Scholarships for Fall 2022




The Lake Superior College Foundation will be awarding over \$150,000 in scholarships for students planning on attending Lake Superior College for Fall Semester 2022. The LSC Foundation scholarship application window will open Monday, February 14, and remain open until Monday, March 14. Current and prospective students planning on attending LSC for Fall Semester 2022 are encouraged to apply. The application process is completely online and will be available once the application window opens on February 14. Several scholarships will be available including program specific scholarships in each academic division (liberal arts/transfer, business and industry, and allied health and nursing) as well as general scholarships, workforce development scholarships and more.

Every year we receive four times more applications than we have awards to give; however some scholarships, with very specific criteria, sometimes don't have any eligible applicants. So, we really encourage anyone interested in applying. We've made the application quite simple, with a short series of qualifying questions and then 3-4 essay questions. Even if you're not awarded a scholarships this cycle, we keep applications on file for up to a year so that if additional funding becomes available other scholarships may be awarded.
