Lake Superior College to Participate at Duluth and St. Louis County Days at the Capitol





LSC will join several other higher education institutions and organizations throughout the Northland to advocate for legislative priorities for the region, including LSC's bonding request to expand, enhance and relocate the manufacturing program from its current downtown location back to main campus. This project will allow LSC to continue to increase efforts to recruit, train and retain a pipeline of manufacturing talent for employers throughout the region and ensure LSC and Duluth remains the premier manufacturing training destination in our region. 
Please keep masking up, IceHawks!

Safety remains our highest priority. Masks/face coverings continue to be required inside all public spaces on all Lake Superior College campus

locations, regardless of vaccination status. Even though the City of Duluth's Mask Mandate has expired, the Minnesota State system - under the guidance of the Minnesota Department of Health - is still requiring face masks at colleges and universities that are in counties with substantial or high transmission rates, according to the CDC COVID Data Tracker: https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#county-view. Since the rate in St. Louis County still remains substantial, masks will continue to be required on all Lake Superior College campuses at this time. Lake Superior College will have the opportunity to remove the mask mandate when St. Louis County has 7 consecutive days of low or moderate transmission rates, and/or when or if Minnesota State changes their guidance. There have been some conversations at the system level of ending the mandate in the coming weeks or months. In fact Minnesota State Chancellor, Devinder Malhotra, put out a memo yesterday, March 1, signaling the start of changes to that guidance. While it doesn't directly change anything at LSC just vet, it at least signals some light at the end of the tunnel. Case numbers will continue to be evaluated especially after Spring Break. Any changes to campus mask requirements will be communicated via email, social media and on the LSC website. Please stay tuned, but for now the mask mandate remains in place.
