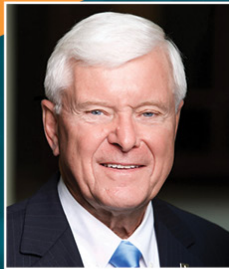

Lake Superior College will hold its Commencement ceremonies on Monday, May 16, at the Duluth Entertainment Convention Center (DECC). They will be the first full, in-person ceremonies since prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. At least 814 students are eligible to walk in this year's Commencement, the largest graduating class since 2019.

This year's Commencement speakers will include: LSC Student Senate President Ijshanita Dunigan, a Duluth Denfeld graduate who will be graduating LSC with her Associates of Arts (AA); Minnesota State Trustee Roger Moe; and Keynote Speaker Tom Segal, President and CEO of Duluth Pack and Spring Creek Outfitters. Both of Mr. Segal's companies employ graduates of Lake Superior College and he will be addressing the importance of giving back to and serving our community, leadership, integrity, taking risks and being proud of where you are/come from.

The Lake Superior College Nurses Pinning Ceremony will take place at 11:00 a.m. in Symphony Hall, at the DECC, to honor the approximately 109

students receiving their Nursing AS or their Practical Nursing Diploma.

Lake Superior College's Commencement Ceremony will take place at 2:00 p.m. in Amsoil Arena, at the DECC, to honor the approximately 814 students graduating Lake Superior College.

LSC's Commencement is free and open to the public. No tickets are required. All are welcome to come cheer on and celebrate LSC's Class of 2022. There is a \$10 fee to park at the DECC. For more information on LSC's Commencement, please visit: lsc.edu/commencement.

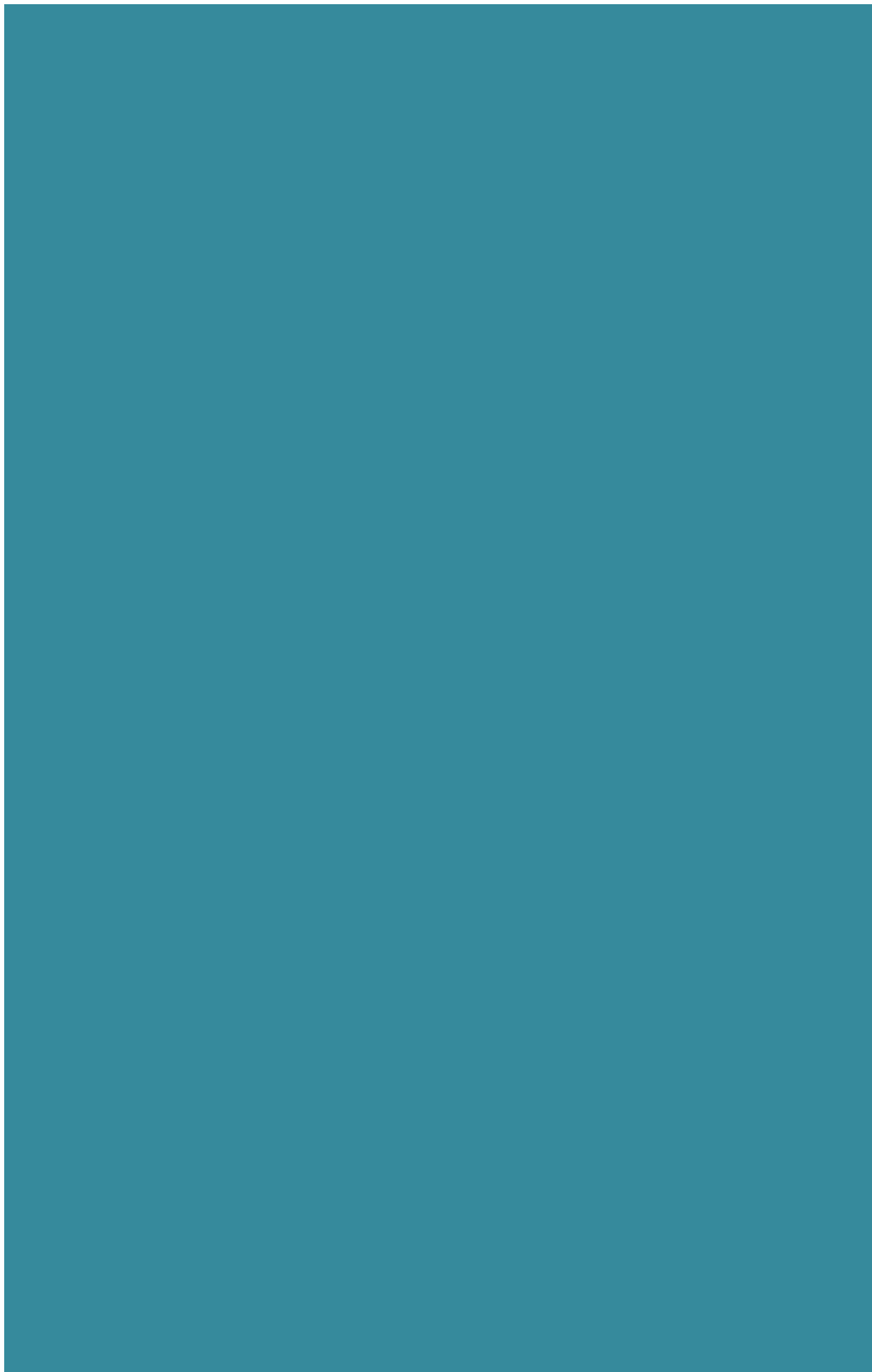
