Must be a full time student with 12 credits or more</li> <li>3. Minimum 2.5 GPA</li> </ol>

Funds may be used for PTA licensure fees</li> </ol>

Must have completed at least 15 credits at LSC, with 80% of those credits earned by online LSC courses</li> <li>2. Minimum 3.0 GPA for LSC coursework</li> <li>3. May reapply every year as long as a minimum of 12 credits were earned from LSC during previous year</li> </ol>
