What is e-Services?

e-Services is the system you will use to register for courses, view your bill and find financial aid information. You can also use your e-Services to update your contact information, view your grades and print important documents, such as your interactive degree audit report and your academic record (i.e. unofficial transcript).

How to login to e-Services:

- 1. Go to www.lsc.edu
- 2. At the top of the page, hover over the icon: Login V
- 3. Select "e-Services" from the list
- 4. Enter your StarID (ab1234cd) and password and click "Login"

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e-Services and Financial Aid What does my "Next Step" mean?

FAFSA: You have not sent your 20 xx - 20 xx FAFSA results to Lake Superior College. Take 15 minutes and get your FAFSA filed now at www.fafsa.gov.

This means that Lake Superior College has not received your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) results electronically. Once you submit your FAFSA on <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>, it takes about 5 to 7 days for LSC to receive it. You may receive an email from the FSA Processors, letting you know that they have completed processing your FAFSA and will be sending the results to your chosen school(s), but this is just the beginning of the financial aid process.



This means there are additional steps required to complete the financial aid process. Follow the link displayed in the box below this step, or click on **Aid Application Status** on the left side of the page to see your Aid Application Status Letter. This letter will explain what additional steps will need to be taken before your financial aid is packaged. Do not make any corrections to your FAFSA application at this time, unless instructed to in the letter. If you have any questions after reading through this letter, please contact Financial Aid. Also, be sure to check your **LSC Email** for additional information or requests from the Financial Aid Office.

Don't see a letter? That means we are currently processing the information that we have and don't require anything additional at this time. Keep checking back for updates!



Congratulations! You have completed the financial aid process and we have begun to prepare your financial aid package. You will be able to check back here to view your Award Notification, when it's complete.



You can view your Award Notification. You will use your Award Notification to do the following things:

- View the types of aid you may be eligible for, including grants, work study and federal student loans. Hover over the icon to learn more about the different types of aid.
- Use the dropdown menu to select the amount of credits you plan to take per semester and see how this can affect your financial aid. This is informational, and will not determine the amount of aid you are eligible for. Your aid will be applied based on the number of credits you are enrolled in after the first week of the semester.
- If you are eligible for grants, they will automatically be accepted for you. If you are eligible for work study and wish to use it, you have the option to accept all of the work study or just a portion of the work study funding that you are eligible for.
- Some types of fees are not typically covered by your financial aid, so by accepting the Miscellaneous Charges agreement, you can use your financial aid to pay for things such as library fines, graduation fees and late fees.
- In order to submit your Work Study Acceptance or the Miscellaneous Charges agreement, you must submit your award notification, which is done on the last page.

There are some things that you *cannot* do from your Award Notification:

- You cannot "accept" your loans. If you wish to use your federal student loans, you must request to do so by clicking on the Request Loans link in your Award Notification, or by clicking on Loans on the left side of the screen. In order to process your loan request, you must complete *all* required steps.
- You cannot "accept" the PLUS loan. The PLUS loan is a loan that only parents can request to use. The loan is in the parent's name, and they are responsible for making the repayments. Parents who wish to request the PLUS loan can find out how to do so by going to www.lsc.edu/financial-aid/loans.
- Once you submit your Award Notification, you will not be able to access it. If you need to review your financial aid package, you can do so by clicking **Awards by Credit Level** on the left side of the screen.
