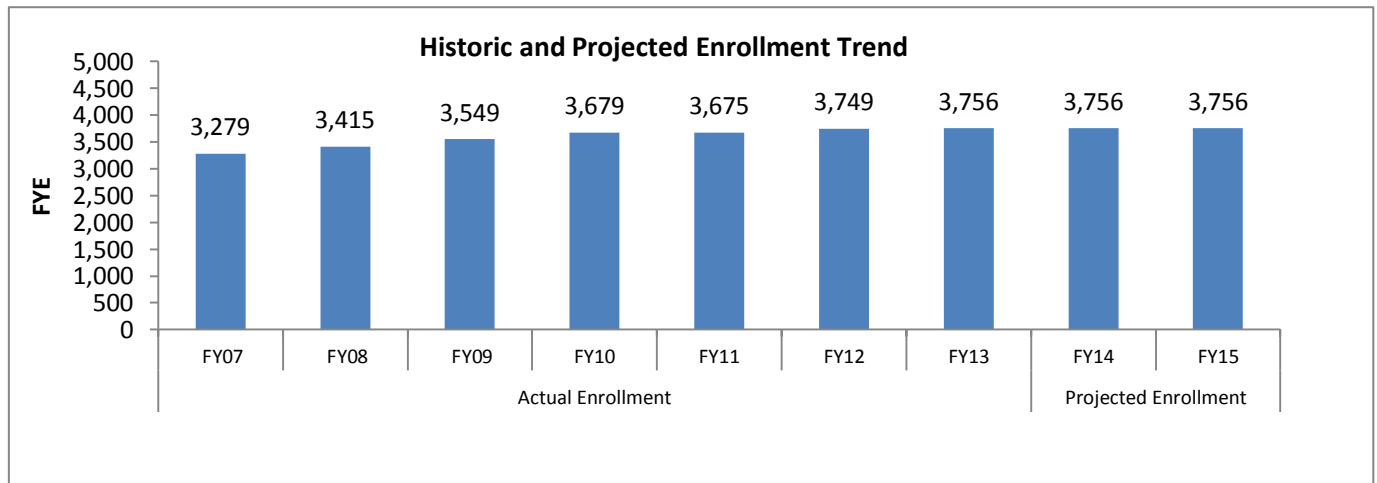

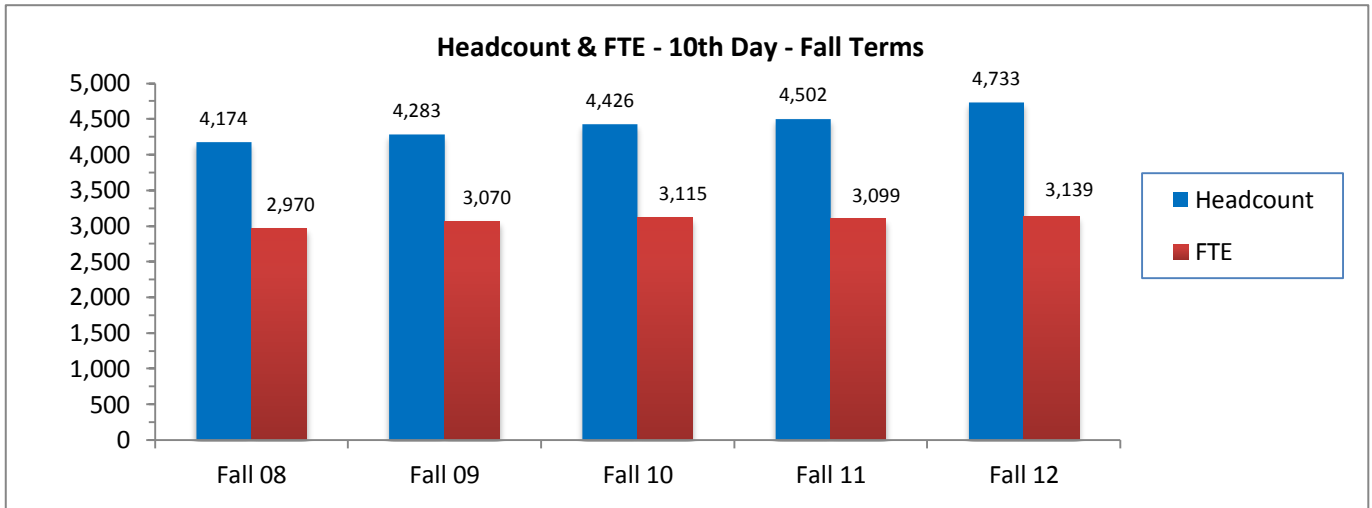

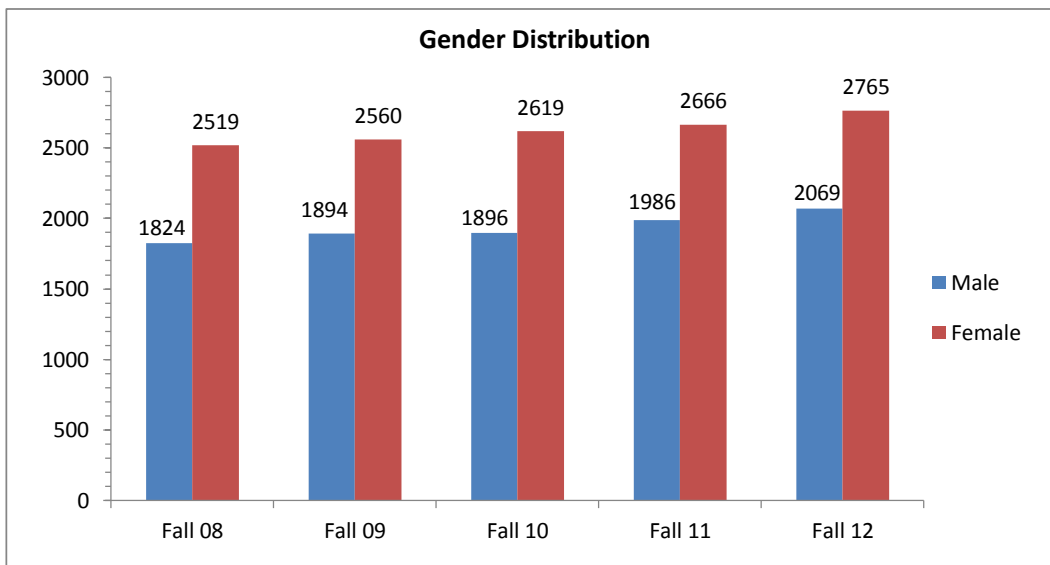

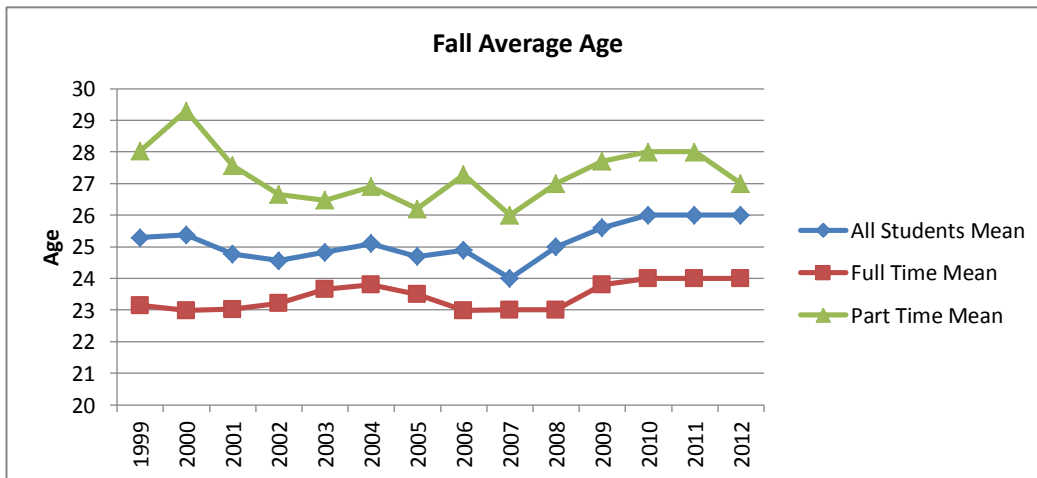

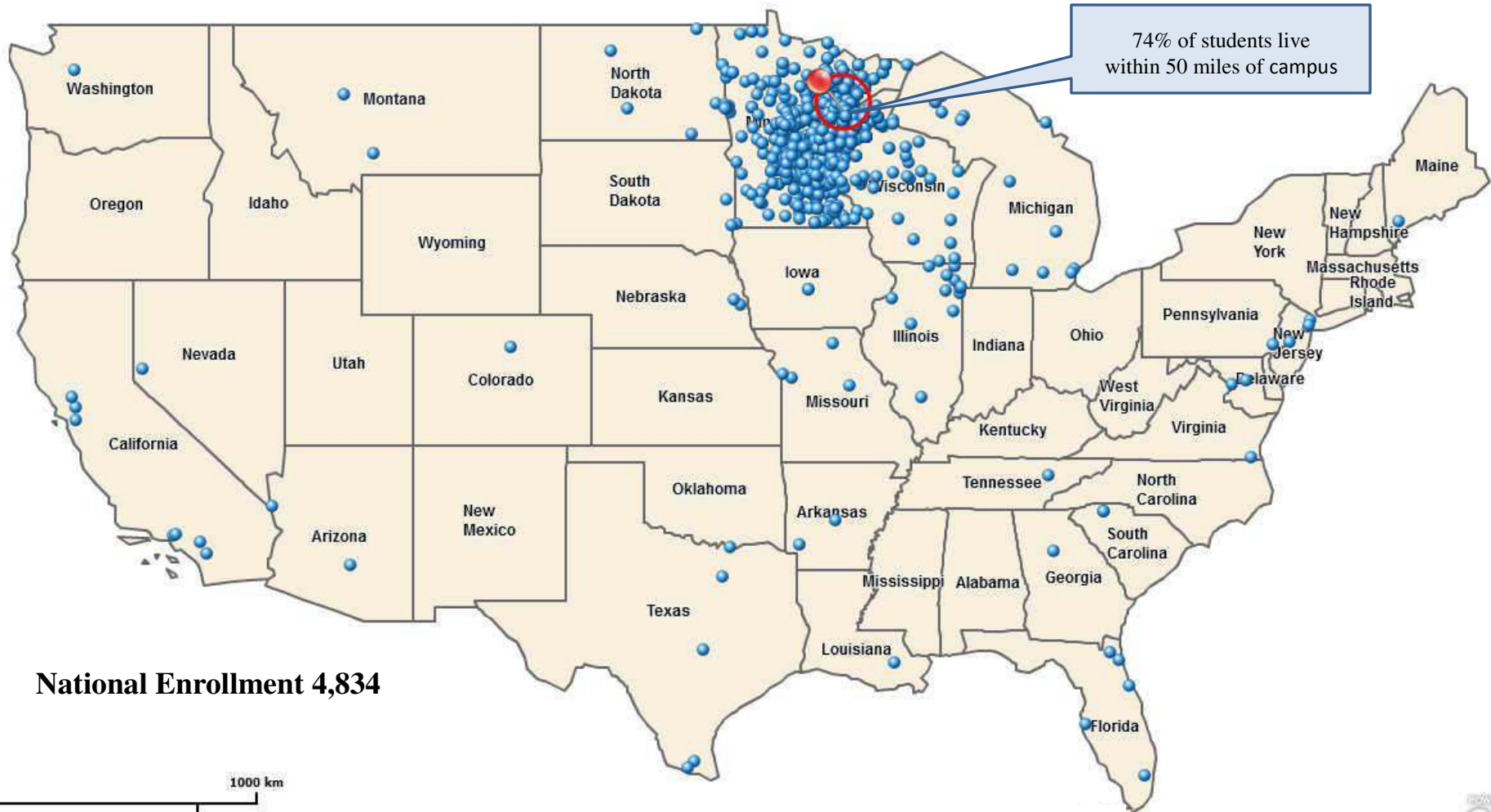

# Map 1 National Enrollment Fall 2012

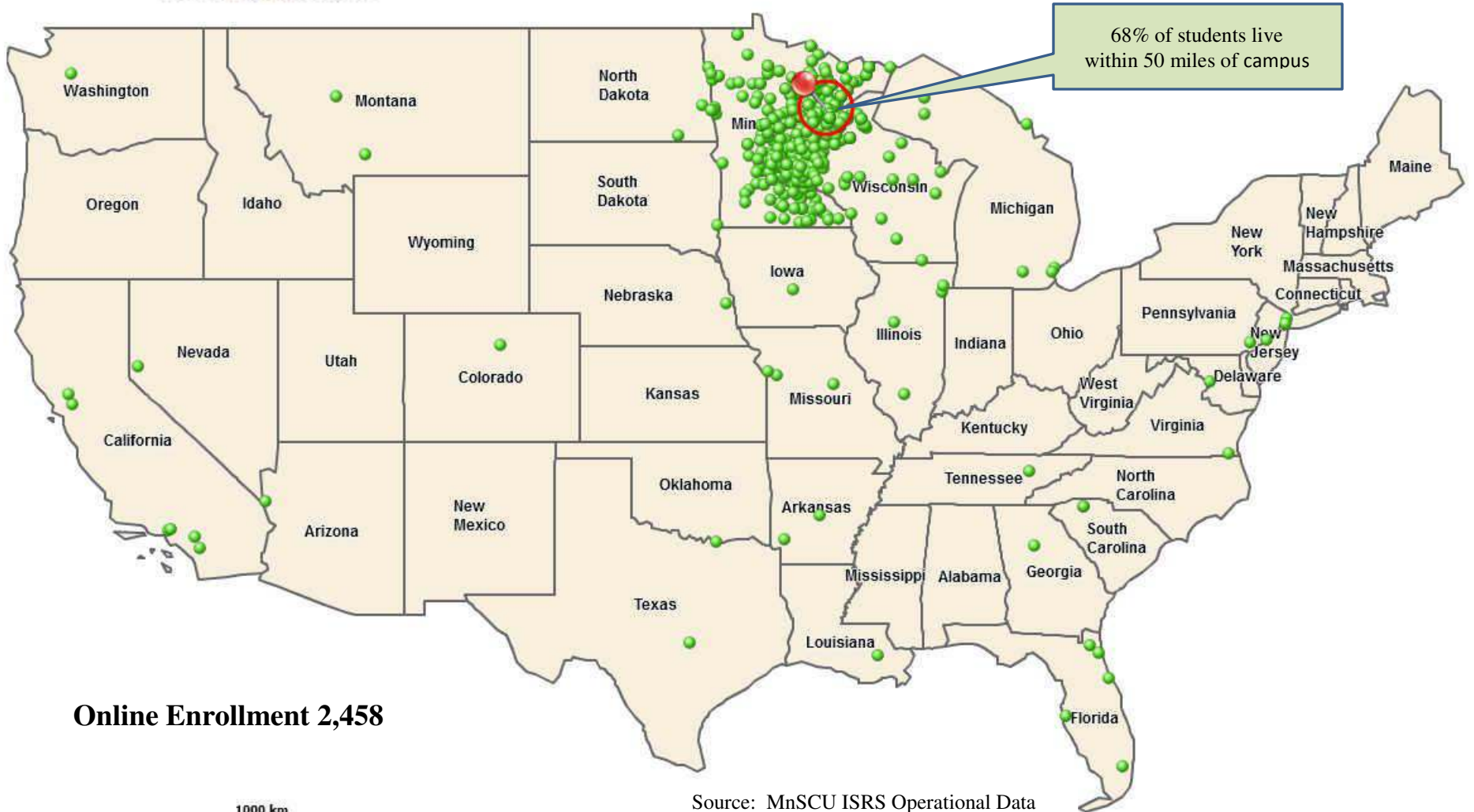

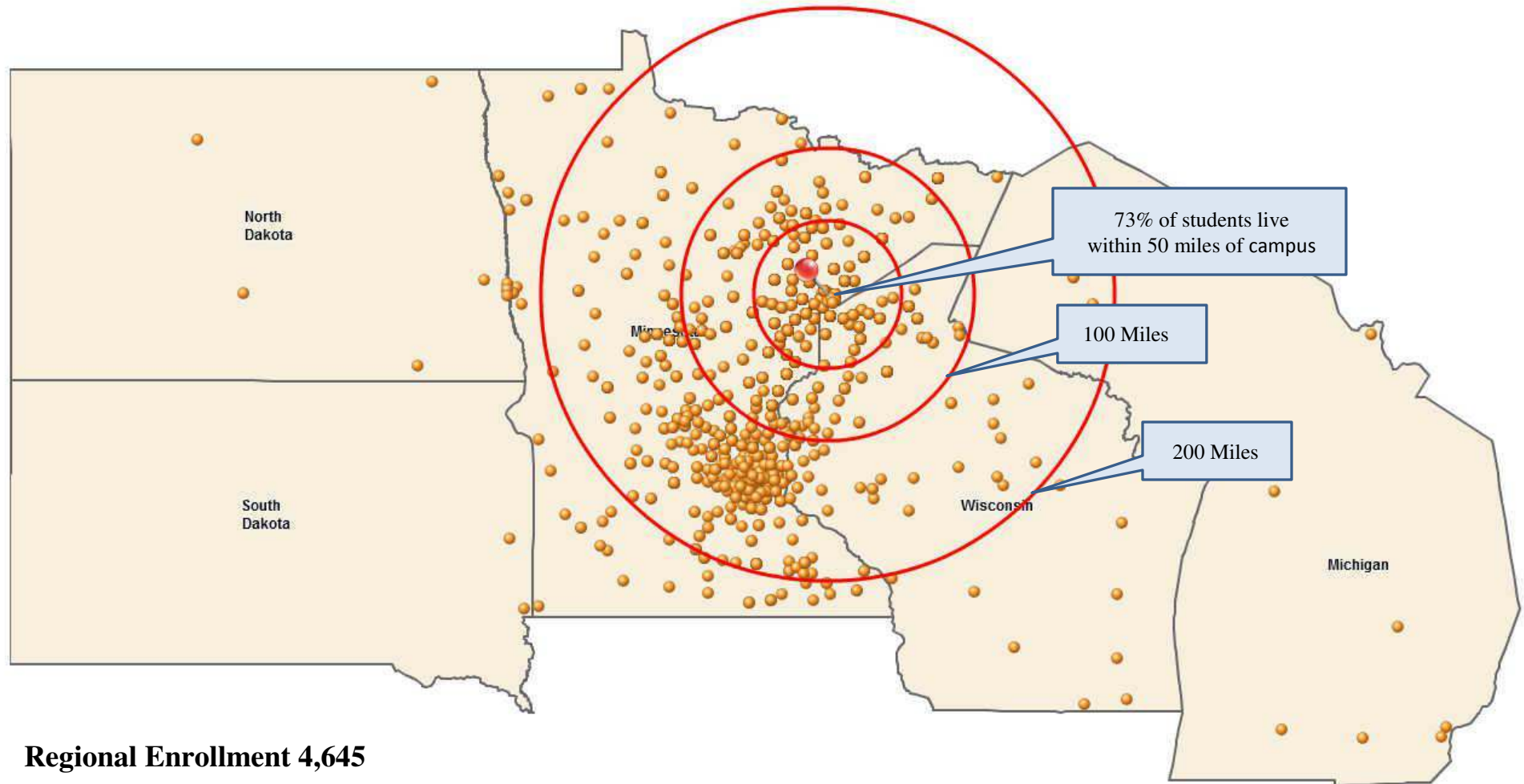

# Map 2 National Online Enrollment Fall 2012

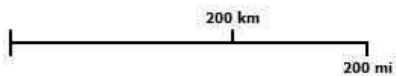




# Map 3 Regional Enrollment Fall 2012

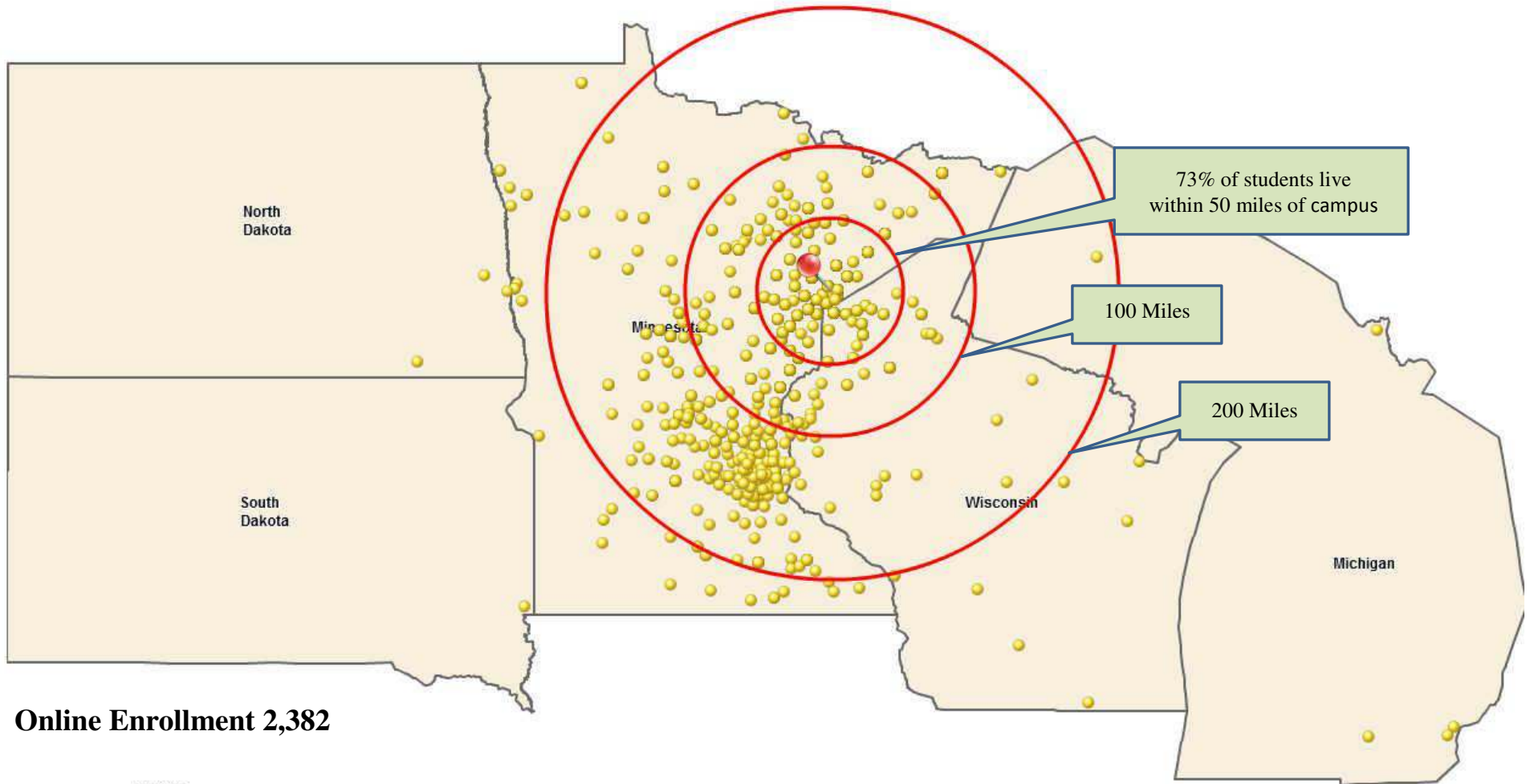

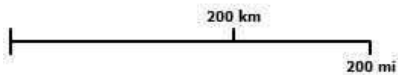

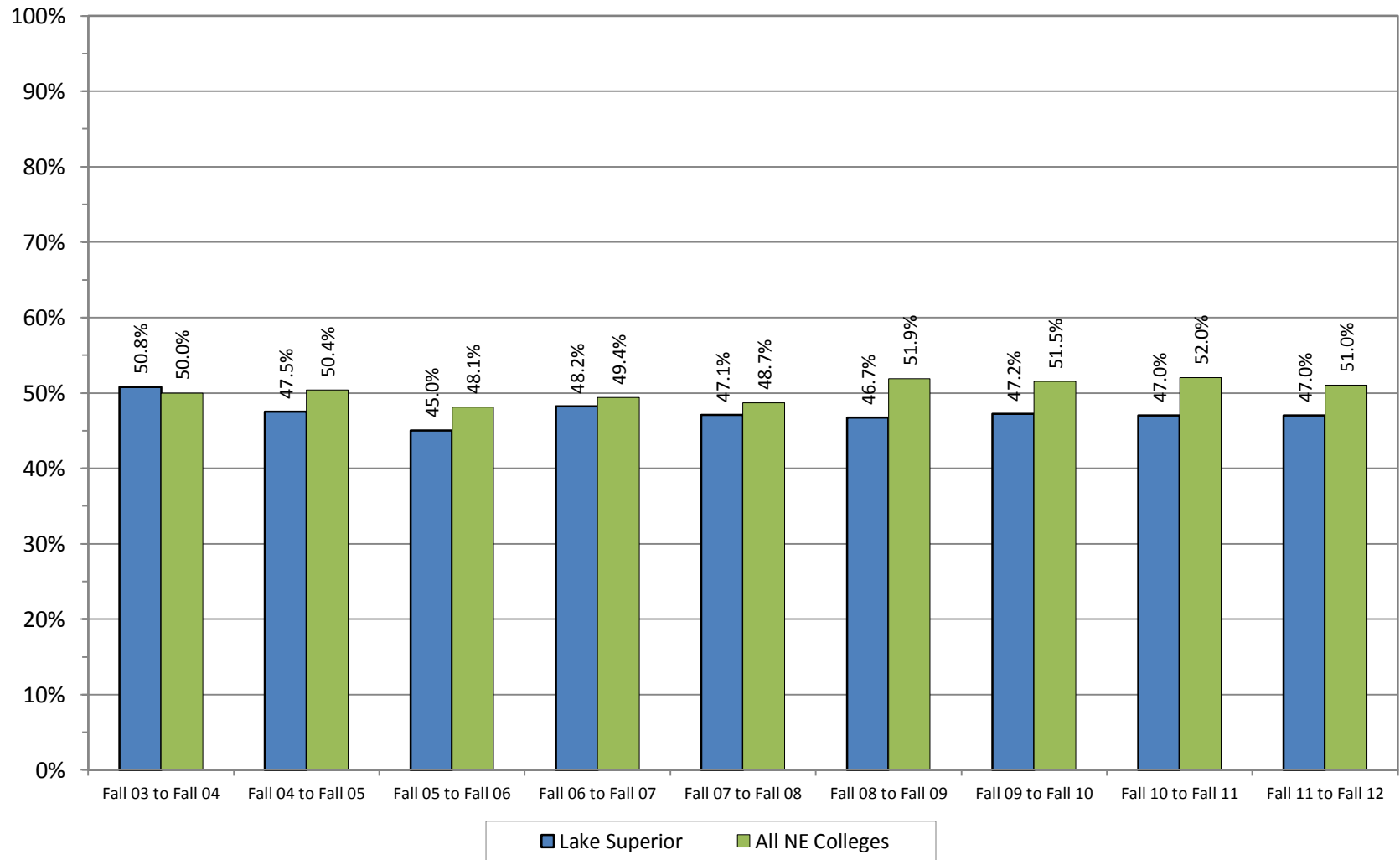
